

2010 Annual Conference Frequently Asked Questions

Which meals are included in the registration fee?

The Wednesday Welcome Reception; Thursday Breakfast, Lunch and Exhibitor Reception; Friday Breakfast, Lunch and Sweet Dreams Reception; and, Saturday Breakfast are all included in the registration fee.

Are day passes available?

Day passes are not available for the 2010 Annual Conference.

Are guests allowed?

Guest passes are available for \$75 each and includes the Wednesday Welcome Reception, Thursday Exhibitor Reception, Friday Sweet Dreams Reception and Saturday Board Installation Breakfast.

Is there childcare available?

Please contact the Seattle Sheraton Hotel at (206) 621-9000 if you require child care.

Is parking available at the hotel?

Yes. The Seattle Sheraton has parking available for \$40 per 24-hr period and includes in-and-out privileges.

I am a Pinnacle Partner, how do I register?

How do I access the online syllabus?

The conference syllabus is only offered online. AAMSE will send information on how to gain access to the online syllabus in early July. Registrants may download and print all or selected sections of the syllabus. Printers will not be available onsite for printing materials.

Can I earn CAE hours?

You may earn one credit hour towards CAE certification or recertification for each full clock hour, up to a maximum of 6 hours for each full-day program. Please note, however, that sessions specific to AAMSE procedures and/or medical topics will not earn credit, and all credits are subject to the determination of the CAE program.

What should I wear?

Daytime July temperatures in Seattle average between 75° and 98°. Packing an umbrella is recommended. Appropriate dress for conference sessions is business casual. Social events and receptions are casual.
